Vision with no action is a daydream - Action with no vision is a nightmare - Actions not aligned to the vision can be disastrous

### A Vision Statement says: Our dream is...

Vision describes the future – where are you headed or where you want to end up. It defines how the organization will function Sample Vision Statements:

"Inspiring individuals to action" Verde valley Leadership Program

"To be an evolutionary solution for sustainability" Clarkdale Sustainability Project

#### A Mission Statement says: We will provide...

Mission – action – what are we doing today A Mission may change – it is reviewed every year. Sample Mission Statement:

Provides growth opportunities, leadership skills and community issues training while cultivating diverse influential networks

Verde Valley Leadership Program

Goals are high level To Dos and have broad targets

Objectives are measurable actions accomplished within a defined period, target, money and people

Vision 2020 covers many goals and objectives

#### Participants' discussion on:

- How to get people involved with BCRC;
- Challenges with a limited core of community volunteers;
- Building consensus and coherence;
- Reasons people don't perform

Desired performance is punishing. Nonperformance is rewarding.

Performance doesn't matter. There are obstacles to performing.

People need to know what is expected of them. – What is the prime motivator?

Train everyone – build an army.

Align resources with priorities.

Update plan routinely.

Measure progress / have a baseline to measure against.

Evaluate new ideas

Review

- Culture of accountability what are the issues what actions are we going to take owners who will do it.
- Guiding principles integrity; teamwork; quality; accountability; leadership; stewardship
   Never compromise out integrity

The board is made up 100% of graduates of the Verde Valley Leadership program. It is a trained board - trained at VV Leadership - the next president trains a year before. Everyone finds their own replacement. Each has their own vision and mission statement. Tuition costs \$450.00. Recommends interested Council members enroll in program.
