On Friday, September 19, the State Transportation Board voted to accept the low bid for the \$10 million ramp improvement project for the McGuireville Interchange. The project also includes widening the dry beaver creek bridges and redoing the decking on them. This must be done in order to lengthen northbound ramp toward Flagstaff and the southbound ramp from the Flagstaff direction. At the conclusion of this year+ long project, all four ramps will have been lengthened to AASHTO standards. There will be no closures of the interchange. The overpass may possibly need to be closed for one night. This type of detail will be discussed on Wednesday evening. The contract was awarded to Fisher Sand & Gravel Co. DBA Southwest Asphalt Paving, and construction is expected to begin within a month. **Please send a representative to the October BCRC meeting to take back information to your organization and neighbors.**
