


NEW DIRECTOR KENT ELSWORTH

SUPERVISOR DAVIS REVIEWED THE STATE BUDGETS AND AREAS OF SHORTFALL AND EXPLAINED ITS IMPACT TO YAVAPAI COUNTY BUDGET AND BUDGET PROCESS & REDUCED REVENUES
