What is aftershock!??? - A K-8 after-school program at Beaver Creek School designed to provide academic support and enrichment in a safe envi9rnoment that is cost effective for BCS families.

Aftershock! Is offered two sessions a day, Monday – Friday.

We are currently serving an average of 65+ students per day who are participating in the following activities:

- Daily Homework Assistance / Tutoring (20 30 / day)
- Grade-level Math Tutoring (10 12 / day)
- Art Club (15)
- Computer Lab (15 20 / day)
- Hip Hop Dance Class (85)
- Class Guitar (12)
- Music Makers (21)
- English Language Support (5 8 / day)
- Reading Buddies (15 20 / day)

Through the generous donations of the Lake Montezuma Property Owners Association, Southwest Expeditions Institute and the Beaver Creek Kiwanis, we are paying for a high schools senior to come and help tutor the students in the homework club.

In June, the Beaver Creek Elementary School District Governing Board allotted regular operating funds to pay an after school coordinator Mrs. Charity Worden. She is on site Monday – Friday until 5 PM to make sure wall students are home safe and to provide tutoring.

The Tax Credit donations from last year are helping to pay for the Hip Hop Class, the Art Class supplies, the guitar class and the bus driver and gas for the 4:20 activity bus. It costs \$35 a day for the school to run the activity bus that even goes up on the mesa. Once again this year we are gearing up for our tax credit drive. Forms will be sent to all past donors.
