Update on Food Backpack Program

- first week went well
- served 5 families, 10 children
- expanded to 7 families, 17 children in 2nd week
- goal of 75 children by the end of the year
- Dr. Daniel Bright Elementary in Cottonwood and Clarkdale Elementary are also participating
- anyone can make a tax deductable donation at verdefood.org!

Update on Aftershock Program at Beaver Creek School

- it is an afterschool daycare program
- 30 children are signed up but one never knows how many are going to come on any given day
- Annika Head is working to set up a daily schedule and curriculum with education based games and activities such as arts and crafts, science experiments, interactive games, and computer time
- working on getting supplies
- Kiwanis is making a generous donation with the proceeds from the Spaghetti Dinner
- also working on a hip hop dance class available to Aftershock students first and then possibly opening it up to the rest of the school
- need more funding to hire more staff so program can be made available to more children

Karin Ward announced that the school has received 20 spots from Head Start for the preschool

- Beaver Creek is going to operate as a satellite of Camp Verde
- school will receive new playground equipment, new carpeting, a teacher, and an aide
- will still be able to use own curriculum
- will begin in January 2010
