Youth and Families Report for June 2009

- Beaver Creek School is now health licensed for childcare and has slots open this summer from 730AM -6 PM. So far ten students are enrolled at \$1 per hour!
- The academic summer school has 35 students in the morning. It is full and runs for the first three weeks of June.
- The June afternoon program has about 50 students ages k-8 and starts a at noon with a free lunch. Activities start at 12:30 and run until 4PM. Staffing is provided by volunteers, NACOG for youth, Vista for youth and adults, and some school funds. Bussing to the pool is funded by Southwest Expedition Institute and other local funds. The bus runs at 11:30 to pick up students and leaves the school at 4 PM for the ride home. Monday and Wednesday is art, life's sports, and computer lab. Tuesday and Thursday have water activities including swimming starting next week. And Fridays is bowling at the Casino. The cost works out to about \$2.25 a day.
- The Key Club has two June activities at the Beaver Creek school Gym for 13-18 year olds: June 12 from 6-9 game night and Social Night June 26 from 6-9 for music and food and fun. Code of conducts will be signed for students to participate.
- Food distribution on May 23rd reached 60 families and about 185 people, thanks to support from the Central Arizona food bank. The next food distribution will be Saturday, June 20 from 8-10 AM.
- The next Co-op Care box distribution is a June 30th payment of \$15 for a July 8 food box delivery. The July delivery will come at 2 PM directly from the Central Arizona food Bank!
- Of course Bountiful Baskets continue every other Saturday at the school. Pay by 10 PM tonight for this Saturday's delivery. This payment must be made on-line.
- Still to come... leadership workshop for the Key club in July and summers sports camps.
- In July daycare will still be available.
- Now for the exciting news. The Youth and Families committee wrote a grant for a
 Recovery Vista worker to help coordinate activities this next year. We were awarded the
 worker. The cost will be between \$3000 and \$5200 for a 40 hour a week year round
 worker helping us secure grants and coordinate activities!!!!
